S.p.A. and Board member of various companies of the group. She currently sits on the Boards of Directors of Fondazione Umano Progresso, Social Impact Agenda per l'Italia, Life Based Value srl and is member of the General Council of Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo.

Felice Scalvini is a lawyer that after some experience in finance, in 1981, he dedicated himself to the rising phenomenon of social cooperation of which he has been a national leader, bringing the occurrence to legislative recognition, and to the political and entrepreneurial infrastructure. He has been Board member of Fondazione Cariplo and president of the Housing Sociale Foundation. From 2013 to 2018, he has been welfare counsellor of the Municipality of Brescia.

He is currently the President of Assifero and Fondazione Asm.

Carola is the first Italian woman to be member and Chairman of the Board (since 2021) of DAFNE (Donors and Foundations Networks in Europe). She is member of the Board of Ariadne (European Funders for Social Change and Human Rights), ECFI (European Community Foundation Initiative), Alliance Magazine and Ashoka Italia. In 2017 she was Senior Fellow at the Centre on Philanthropy and Civil Society of the City University of New York.
